Demurrage and detention rules and tariffs effective from January 2017

Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to hereby announce that demurrage and detention rules and tariffs will be changed effective from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 for exports/imports from/to South Korea. Please refer to below for detailed information.

Import (Combined demurrage and detention)

Dry containers

Days	Rate (KRW) per 20'/40'/45'
1-11 days	Free
12-16 days	11,000/22,000/22,000
17-21 days	22,000/44,000/44,000
After 22 days	44,000/88,000/88,000

Reefer and special containers

Days	Rate (KRW) per 20'/40'/45'
1-7 days	Free
8-14 days	50,000/70,000/70,000
After 15 days	70,000/90,000/90,000

- Effective date: January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017, discharge date basis
- Calendar day. Combined demurrage and detention starts from discharge day (included), ends with gate-in empty day (included) to terminal. In case place of delivery is at inland locations served by truck, it starts from full container's gate-in day (included) at place of delivery.

Export (Combined demurrage and detention)

Dry containers

Days	Rate (KRW) per 20'/40'/45'
1-17 days	Free
18-31 days	10,000/20,000/20,000
After 32 days	20,000/40,000/40,000

Reefer and special containers

Days	Rate (KRW) per 20'/40'/45'
1-8 days	Free
9-15 days	40,000/60,000/60,000
After 16 days	60,000/80,000/80,000

- Effective date: January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017, load date basis
- Calendar day. Combined demurrage and detention starts from empty pick up day (included), ends with loading day (included) to vessel. In case place of receipt is at inland locations served by truck, it ends with full container's gate-out day (included) at place of receipt.
