**Emergency Inland Fuel Surcharge
For All USA and Canada LCL Import & Export Shipments
Effective April 20th, 2026**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to ongoing volatility in global energy markets and the resulting increase in fuel costs affecting container drayage and inland transportation, Maersk will implement an **Emergency Inland Fuel Surcharge** for all USA and Canada LCL Import and Export shipments.

This surcharge will take effect **April 20th, 2026**, and will apply to all USA and Canada LCL lanes.

Effective Date: April 20th, 2026 (Date of cargo receipt at origin)

Cargo type: Dry Cargo

Scope: All USA and Canada LCL Import & Export Lanes

- **USD 6 per W/M, minimum \$6.00**

These measures are necessary to maintain reliable service levels while managing the escalated inland transportation costs. We will continue to closely monitor market conditions and adjust surcharge levels as required.
