


CUSTOMER DEMAND IS GROWING

The proportion of EU e-shoppers grew from 55% in 2012 to 75% in 2022.1








POOR CUSTOMS CAUSES DELAYS

Digitalisation can seem complex and complicated. But really, it comes down to three key areas: digital interoperability, agile and reliable workflows and actionable data.




