Customer Advisory – Slovakia Rail Infrastructure Works Affecting Intermodal Services

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you of ongoing railway infrastructure modernization and maintenance projects taking place in the Bratislava region of Slovakia. These works are being managed by Železnice Slovenskej republiky (ŽSR), the national railway infrastructure authority, and are impacting rail network capacity across several key corridors.

While rail operations continue to run, the temporary capacity constraints on the Slovak railway network are resulting in longer transit times and operational delays for intermodal services. As railway operators must comply with the infrastructure restrictions and traffic management measures implemented by ŽSR, service schedules may be affected during this period.

Impact on Services to Dunajská Streda Terminal

Due to infrastructure works in the Nové Košariská and Podunajské Biskupice area, combined with reduced capacity on the Kúty – Devínska Nová Ves route, operational handovers that would normally take place in Bratislava have been temporarily relocated to Komárno. As terminal and yard capacity in Komárno is limited, train acceptance into Slovakia is currently being managed according to available reception capacity. Trains may therefore need to wait before entering the Slovak network until a suitable train path is assigned by ŽSR. This situation may lead to extended transit times for shipments moving through this corridor.

Impact on Services to Bratislava Pálenisko (Terminal SPaP)

Rail services destined for Bratislava Pálenisko are currently being routed via Bratislava-Rača. This routing requires additional operational procedures, including train reversal activities and brake checks, before onward movement to the terminal. Combined with the overall reduction in network capacity, these additional handling requirements may contribute to delays in rail transport services to and from the terminal.

We continue to monitor the situation closely together with our rail partners and will provide further updates should there be any significant changes to network conditions. We recommend customers consider potential transit time extensions when planning shipments through Slovakia during this period.
