## ✓ Fuel Trucks will travel via Bluff

- ✓ **NB: NO TRUCKS TO BE ALLOWED BETWEEN 05:00 TO 07:00 ( 13:00 TO 14:15) AND SHOULD THE USE OF BAYHEAD CONTINUE NEXT WEEK - TIMES WILL CHANGE AS**
- ✓ 05:00 TO 08:30 ( 13:00 TO 14:15) AND FOR "HIGH PEAK" (16:00 TO 18:00)
- ✓ No double trailer allowed

## Container Traffic – Use Bayhead Road

- ✓ Will use Bayhead Road from 18h00 tonight, 16 April 2022 as directed by SAPS
- ✓ Shipping Line will submit a list of all containers for approval to (TNPA, TPT and Policing Authority) using the spreadsheet template provided strictly between **06h00 to 08h00 and 16h00 to 18h00**. Any requests received between this time slots will only be considered for the following day.
- ✓ The list of containers must be emailed to contact list on the last slide.
- ✓ Once approved, the Terminal appointments team will allocate slots
  - ✓ Terminal will indicate the number of trucks (through Bookings) that can be allowed into the terminals or port
    - ✓ The number of slots allocated will be determined by the number of requests received.
    - ✓ Shipping line will provide trucking company details, (registration and driver name)
    - ✓ Terminal will create Appointment for the trucks as supplied
    - ✓ Exports reefers will only be allowed in or accepted only if stack is open
- ✓ Once the vehicles has been loaded they will have to depart the Port area with immediate effect

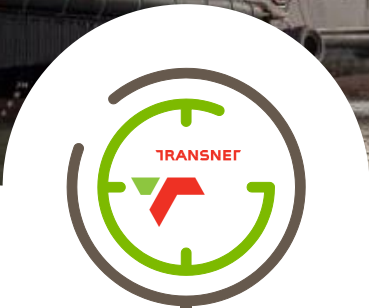
